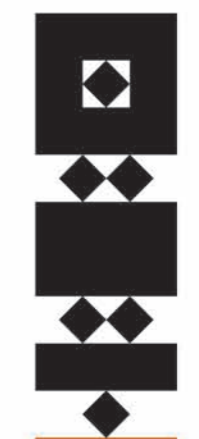

Opera La BOHEME by Puccini A magnificent production by Les Chorégies d'Orange

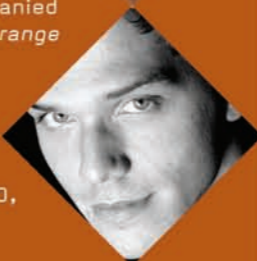
